

American Legion Post 39 Cornhole League registration

League will play on Monday Nights @ 6:30pm in the back banquet room at the North St. Paul American Legion starting January 8, 2024, with the first Monday of each month being an off night due to the banquet room already being booked. Email will go out prior to first night to captains confirming first start date for league. League will run for 9 weeks with the last week being the end of season tournament.

There will be 2 matches per team a night with each round being 45 minutes and being best 2 of 3.

4 matches at each of these times with 4 boards going: 6:15pm, 7pm, 7:45pm

- Teams consist of 2 players (any gender, 1 sub allowed) All participants must be 21+
- Teams can bring their own set of bags. Corn or synthetic corn. Smooth on both sides. **NO** sand filled. Bags will be available if you don't have your own.
- Cash payouts for top team's TBD • The entry fee is \$50 for league – Paid first night of league
- No league play allowed without entry fee paid in full.
- American Legion Leagues are for people who want to have fun!!!

First come first serve basis for sign up. Limited Availability. Only 12 teams

Official Rules

1. Each team has 4 bags to throw. (Rock, Paper, Scissors, or coin flip to choose who goes first). Corn filled bags are the only bags to be used for league play.
2. Bags will be placed on courts before league play begins for those that need bags. Bags are to stay on those specific courts the entire night of league play. Bags are not to be removed or taken by players and placed on other courts.
3. If a player(s) is over 10 minutes late for a match, they must forfeit that match
4. Each player must throw from behind the front of the box. The player **MUST NOT** pass the front of the box, or the throw does not count, and the bag is removed.
5. Each team alternates shots, beginning with the team that scored the last point.
6. SCORING: a. Points are scored when a player has a bag on the board or in the hole. b. Only one team can score points per round because points cancel each other out i. A bag put on the board = 1 point ii. A bag put in the hole = 3 points c. The maximum number of points scored in a single round is 12 points. (4 bags from the same team in the hole)
7. The game is over when one team scores **15** points. a. If a team goes over 15 points, that team goes back to **11** points and continues on.
8. Once you have finished each match the winning team will go over and circle their team number for that match in the official scoring book which will be on a table in the banquet room. We will let you know the location of the book on the first night.

9. A bag that hits another player's bag or any other bag is legal and still in play. If a player throws a bag and the result is that it hits the other player's bag in the hole, that bag in the hole counts as such. If a player knocks another player's bag off of the board, that bag stays off of the board.

10. A bag that hits the ground for any reason is considered dead. If a bag bounces and lands on the board, it is dead and must be removed from the board before play may continue.

11. ***If both players prefer the same side of the board, simply alternate, otherwise each person will have their own side***

12. Subs – If a team has a sub(s), that sub(s) must play the entire night. All scheduled matches. Subs are for the entire night of play and cannot come in and out of play throughout the night.

NO outside alcoholic beverages or food are allowed. All beverages and food must be purchased from the bar.
